Dear Maureen,

Thank you for your generous gift to the Humane Society of the United States. Your incredible support helps fund our fights that make this a kinder, safer world for all animals. The HSUS has made incredible progress toward our strategic objectives over the past year, and I'm proud to share some highlights of our work made possible by your donation:

- We worked with lawmakers in Utah on successful passage of a bill to ban cages for egg laying hens, the eighth state where we have secured monumental wins for farm animals. Every year, 100 million hens are spared from the deprivation and suffering of spending virtually their entire lives in crowded cages, thanks to your support.
- Our Horrible Hundred report documented multiple examples of failures by the U.S. Department of Agriculture to enforce federal law at puppy mills across the country. We're pushing for stronger laws and better enforcement at the local, state and national levels. We worked with advocates and members of the city council in San Antonio, Texas, to pass an ordinance stopping the sale of dogs from puppy mills in pet stores and Washington State became the latest to restrict sales of puppies in pet stores. Close to 400 communities have enacted similar measures.
- Our campaign to end the use of fur in fashion scored a huge win when Nordstrom, one of the largest luxury fashion retailers, announced it will stop selling products made with fur and exotic animal skins by the end of 2021. The list of designers who are going fur-free continues to grow and legislation to end fur sales is advancing in several states.
- We went undercover to wildlife killing contests to document these gruesome events and are making the case for state and federal laws against them. Thanks to your support, eight states and counting now ban wildlife killing contests.
- The mystery of the missing tiger in Houston made headlines around the world and we reiterated our concern about private ownership of big cats on national news outlets. Once law enforcement officers safely recovered India, he moved to our Black Beauty Ranch where he will live the rest of his life in a safe and more natural environment.

Thanks to your support, we will continue our momentum toward the ultimate goal of making this a more humane world for animals.
